Reading Guild of Artists say “Hooray” for Henley!

The Reading Guild of Artists (RGA) is holding its 87th Annual Exhibition, 'Hooray Henley!', The Old Fire Station Gallery, Henley-on-Thames from Saturday 18 to Tuesday 28 March 2017. The exhibition will be open daily, 10am to 4pm, including Sundays and entry is free.

The exhibition will showcase an eclectic mix of work, with examples of batik, prints, woven textiles, paint and in three-dimensions. Works will be available for sale, both framed and unframed.

Anthony Wilder, chairman of the Reading Guild of Artists, said: “The title 'Henley Hooray!' is designed to encourage local people and visitors to Henley, to call in to see our exhibition. Though mainly based in and around Reading, the RGA membership also includes at least 7 artists living and working in Henley.

“All our members are being encouraged to enter at least one piece of work based on those things for which Henley is famous: the river and locality, well-known characters, Henley's festivals, local history, industry or architecture. I would encourage people to pop in and see the width and breadth of talent on display and to hopefully, buy a piece of art.

“We look forward to welcoming all visitors, both from Henley and further afield.”
