'Sense of Space' A Collaborative Exhibition - RGA & SHP

The Reading Guild of Artists' (RGA) exhibition 'Sense of Space' at South Hill Park Arts Centre (SHP) Bracknell gives visitors the opportunity to reflect on, remember and to restore their own sense of space, especially after the restrictions of the past many months.

Until 22 May, visitors can explore this exhibition in the Atrium and Balcony galleries within the Georgian mansion at South Hill Park. An audio guide is available to enable visitors with sight impairment to access the works on display. A QR code in the gallery takes the visitor to a YouTube playlist of the audio descriptive videos.

The newly elected President of the RGA, Fiona Talkington of BBC Radio 3, thought the spaces of South Hill Park were clearly an inspiration to many artists exhibiting. Fiona said it is 'thrilling to be able to share in some of that inspiration, to spend time with vast canvases and small prints, with silhouettes and ceramics and to reflect on the skills and talents of so many members of the RGA'. This exhibition encourages the viewer to look, see and connect with some of the feelings the artists have attempted to portray in their work. Both the RGA and SHP hope that the wide variety of art works on display, the range of subject matter depicting a sense of space, and the joy of experiencing 'art in the flesh' will be a source of great pleasure for all who come to South Hill Park Arts Centre.
