'A strong advocate of *plein-air* painting, Ray's main objective is to capture the mood and spirit of a place. To reinforce these ideas, he introduced the appraisals by identifying the key elements to look for in a picture, especially the requirement to 'love' the subject, without which success can be difficult to achieve.

'There was a variety of subject matter and a range of materials used. The discussions Ray held with the individual artists as each piece was considered was lively, analytical and well received. His professional advice was extremely useful to all the members as indicators to help when reflecting on their own work.'
